I refer to your request, dated 29th July, 2020 and further clarified and received on the 30th July, 2020 which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 (FOI Act) for records held by An Garda Síochána.

Part 1(n) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act states that An Garda Síochána is listed as a partially included agency "*insofar as it relates to administrative records relating to human resources, or finance or procurement matters*". Therefore, only administrative records that relate to human resources, finance or procurement shall be considered.

I would like to request the spend of the dog unit for 2019 and 2020

I wish to inform you that I have decided to **grant** your request on the 6th August, 2020.

The purpose of this letter is to explain that decision.
