Re: Freedom of Information Request FOI-000014-2015

Dear

I refer to the Freedom of Information Act 2014 and your submission to this body dated 14/10/2015 and received on 14/10/2015.

Part 1 of Schedule 1 of the Freedom of Information Act 2014 states that An Garda Síochána is listed as a partially included agency *"insofar as it relates to administrative records relating to human resources, or finance or procurement matters"*. Therefore, only administrative records that relate to human resources, finance or procurement shall be considered.

Your request is shown below:

"Details of any records showing how many serving gardai are working a second job"

I, _____ wish to inform you that your request has been refused.

The purpose of this letter is to explain my decision.

1. Findings, particulars and reasons for decision

I am refusing your request on the basis that the Human Resources and People Development does not keep records of second employments which members may or may not have or engage in on a part-time basis. These records, if retained, are kept at local Divisional/District Offices. It would cause a substantial and unreasonable disruption to the Human Resources and People Development section and Operational Divisional and Districts throughout the organisation of An Garda Síochána to

inspect all records held to identify members who have declared second employments. These records are manual records held locally at the Chief Superintendents and Superintendents offices. It would require a disproportionate expenditure of Garda time and resources to inspect the records to identify members who have a second employment.

Section 15(1)(c) of the Freedom of Information Act 2014 is as follows:

15. (1) A head to whom an FOI request is made may refuse to grant the request where—
- (c) *in the opinion of the head, granting the request would, by reason of the number or nature of the records concerned or the nature of the information concerned, require the retrieval and examination of such number of records or an examination of such kind of the records concerned as to cause a substantial and unreasonable interference with or disruption of work (including disruption of work in a particular functional area) of the FOI body concerned,*

In accordance with the requirements of section 15(1) (c), of the Freedom of Information Act 2014, I am refusing your request on this basis.

2. Right of appeal

In the event that you are not happy with this decision you may seek an Internal Review of the matter by writing to the address below and quoting reference number **F01-000014-2015**.

The review will involve a complete reconsideration of the matter by a more senior member of An Garda Síochána and the decision will be communicated to you within 3 weeks. The making of a late appeal may be permitted in appropriate circumstances.
