I refer to the Freedom of Information Act 2014 (FOI Act) and your submission to this body, dated 10th May 2016 and received on 11th May 2016.

Part 1(n) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act states that An Garda Síochána is listed as a partially included agency "insofar as it relates to administrative records relating to human resources, or finance or procurement matters". Therefore, only administrative records that relate to human resources, finance or procurement shall be considered.

Your request:

The amount spent on garden maintenance services and ancillary services by An Garda Siochana in 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015 and 2016. Please provide breakdown of figures by garda division/districts/county.

I wish to inform you that I have made a final decision to partially grant your request on today's date.

The purpose of this letter is to explain that decision.

1. Findings, particulars and reasons for decision to deny access

The sections of the Act which can apply to deny access to documents are known as its exemption provisions.

I am refusing your request under section 15(1)(d) of the FOI Act on the basis that the information is already in the public domain. Refusal on administrative grounds to grant FOI requests
