Dear

I refer to your request dated 11th January 2017 and received 12th January 2017 which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 (FOI Act) for records held by An Garda Síochána.

Part 1(n) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act states that An Garda Síochána is listed as a partially included agency "insofar as it relates to administrative records relating to human resources, or finance or procurement matters". Therefore, only administrative records that relate to human resources, finance or procurement shall be considered. Records that relate to the functions and management of the organisation are restricted.

Your request sought:

'The amount of money An Garda Síochána has spent for towing services in the years 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015 and 2016.

These records should be broken down by year and by Garda Region, and should detail the total cost per annum An Garda Síochána has paid for towing services.'

I wish to inform you that I have decided to grant your request on 26th January 2017.

The purpose of this letter is to explain my decision.

1. Findings, particulars and reasons for decision

On receipt of your request, the Finance Directorate was contacted in order to identify the records relating to the costs of towing services in 2012, 2013 2014, 2015 and 2016.

Towing fees include all vehicles detained under Section 41 of the Road Traffic Act 1994, official Garda vehicles and other vehicles seized or transported by An Garda Síochána for investigative, evidential and technical examination purposes. These figures include sums paid to non contracted firms who had been requested to remove a vehicle in an emergency situation or in cases where the location of the vehicle presented a danger to other road user's required immediate removal. The increase in fees paid from 2015 to 2016 relates to legacy payments from 2014/2015 and an increase in enforcement. The increase in enforcement from 2015 to 2016 resulted in an increase of 7,209 vehicles detained during 2016.

The making of a late appeal may be permitted in appropriate circumstances.
