I refer to the Freedom of Information Act 2014 (FOI Act) and to your submission to this body, dated 10th May 2016 and received on 11th May 2016.

Part 1(n) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act states that An Garda Síochána is listed as a partially included agency "insofar as it relates to administrative records relating to human resources, or finance or procurement matters". Therefore, only administrative records that relate to human resources, finance or procurement shall be considered.

Your request:

'The amount paid for public attitudes survey commissioned by An Garda Siochana in 2014, 2015, 2016 (include those that tenders were sought).'

I wish to inform you that I have made a final decision on today's date to partially grant your request.

The purpose of this letter is to explain that decision.

1. Findings, particulars and reasons for decision to deny access

The sections of the Act which can apply to deny access to documents are known as its exemption provisions.

I am refusing your request under section 15(1)(d) of the FOI Act on the basis that the information is already in the public domain. This information is available on the Garda Síochána Freedom of Information Decision Log on the Garda Website at the following URL:

The objective for An Garda Síochána in undertaking this procurement exercise was to procure the services of a company that would provide a top quality survey of public attitudes relating to satisfaction, victimisation, views on crime, and views on Garda service and how it can be improved. The Public Attitudes Survey was procured following a public tender competition that received a high number of responses from both Ireland and the UK. It involves interviewing 1,500 people per quarter on key areas of the organisation. It provides An Garda Síochána with high quality information that has been used to help the organisation to enhance the service it provides to the public.

In the Decision Log An Garda Síochána publishes a list of all responses issued to Freedom of Information Requests (excluding requests for personal information) from the commencement date of 14th of October 2015. I wish to draw your attention to Decision **FOI-000131-2015** which is applicable to your request.

Refusal on administrative grounds to grant FOI requests

- 15. (1) A head to whom an FOI request is made may refuse to grant the request where—
 - (d) the information is already in the public domain,

However, I wish to provide you with updated information since the publication of FOI-000131-2015.
