Re: Freedom of Information Request FOI-000296-2017 Request Granted

Dear Ms. Colgan,

I refer to your request, dated and received on the 30th June 2017 which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act (FOI) 2014 for records held by An Garda Síochána.

Part 1(n) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act states that An Garda Síochána is listed as a partially included agency "insofar as it relates to administrative records relating to human resources, or finance or procurement matters". Therefore, only administrative records that relate to human resources, finance or procurement shall be considered.

Your request sought:

1. Details of clerical allowances paid to gardai in 2014, 2015 and 2016, including the total amount paid out each year and the number of gardai that received clerical allowances in each year.

I advise that the FOI Act does not confer a general right of access to information; rather it confers a right of access to records. Therefore, your request for information has been treated as a request for access to records containing the information you seek.

I have now made a final decision to grant your request on the 17th July 2017. The purpose of this letter is to explain my decision.

1. Findings, particulars and reasons for decision

Details of your request were provided to the Finance Section within An Garda Síochána who conducted a search for records relating to your request.

The table below sets out the total amount paid in respect of Clerical Allowances in 2014, 2015 and 2016 respectively:

Clerical/Administrative Designated Post Allowance

A member who is employed in a "Garda" designated clerical/administrative post may* receive a designated post allowance. A member occupying a (Civilian) non-designated post may* be paid an ex-gratia sum, equivalent to the allowances mentioned at subsection (1), while he/she occupies such post. Eligibility for the ex-gratia sum will be subject to the following provisions:

- (a) That the member opted to transfer to outdoor duties; and
- (b) That it is not practicable to release the member from the post he/she occupies.

Only members who are employed in posts requiring attendance between 9.15am and 5.15pm on each day between Monday to Friday inclusive, eg. Clerical posts or similar posts, will be entitled to receive the allowance (or the ex-gratia sum). Members who are in receipt of other allowances for special duties, will not be eligible to the paid allowance (or ex-gratia sum) under the terms of this section.

*It should be noted that by way of Government decision of 18th September 2012 both the Clerical Designated allowance and the Clerical Ex-gratia Allowance was abolished for new beneficiaries with effect from 1st February 2012. Any member of An Garda Síochána who takes up a post mentioned at (1) or (2) above will not be paid the relevant allowance if they are deemed to be a new beneficiary.

The recruitment and appointment of up to 500 civilians provided for by Government this year will facilitate the Garda Commissioner in addressing capacity and critical skills gaps across the oganisation including corporate supports, change management, human resources and financial management at the National, Regional and Divisional Level. These appointments will make an important contribution to the delivery of the ambitious reform agenda set out in the Commissioner's Modernisation and Renewal Programme 2016-2021 and will facilitate increased civilianisation in the coming years. This will reduce the number of gardai in administrative positions throughout the organisation,
