Dear Mr. McDermott,

I refer to your request, dated and received on 8th August 2017 which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 (FOI Act) for records held by An Garda Síochána.

Part 1(n) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act states that An Garda Síochána is listed as a partially included agency "insofar as it relates to administrative records relating to human resources, or finance or procurement matters". Therefore, only administrative records that relate to human resources, finance or procurement shall be considered.

Your request sought:

I would like to request information and details of costs related to the implementation of the new Drager Drugtest 5000 system, specifically:

- The cost of any research into the implementation of the Drager Drugtest 5000
- The number of Drager Drugtest 5000 testing kits purchased by An Garda Síochána
- The cost of each Drager Drugtest 5000 testing kit purchased by An Garda Síochána
- Any cost to An Garda Síochána of advertising the implementation of the new Drager Drugtest 5000 system
- Any other costs related to the implementation of the Drager Drugtest 5000 system (e.g. Administrative costs such as postage of kits; or any tendering process)

I wish to inform you that I have decided to refuse your request on the 15th August 2017.

The purpose of this letter is to explain that decision.

1. Findings, particulars and reasons for decision

Details of your request were forwarded to the Procurement Section within An Garda Síochána who conducted a search of their records relating to your request.

I have been advised that the records you have sought are not held by the Procurement Section. I can advise however, that these items were purchased by the Medical Bureau of Road Safety and provided to An Garda Síochána. In this regard, I must refuse your request pursuant to Section 15(1)(a) of the FOI Act which states:

Refusal on administrative grounds to grant FOI request

15(1) A head to whom an FOI request is made may refuse to grant the request where
(a) The record concerned does not exist or cannot be found after all reasonable steps to ascertain its whereabouts have been taken,
