Dear Ms. Colgan,

I refer to your request, dated the 3rd September 2017 and received on the 4th September 2017 which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 (FOI Act) for records held by An Garda Síochána.

Part 1(n) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act states that An Garda Síochána is listed as a partially included agency "insofar as it relates to administrative records relating to human resources, or finance or procurement matters". Therefore, only administrative records that relate to human resources, finance or procurement shall be considered.

Your request sought:

Details of the costs for new segways and maintenance of segways for use by members of An Garda Siochana in 2016.

I wish to inform you that I have decided to refuse your request on the 19th September 2017.

The purpose of this letter is to explain that decision.

1. Findings, particulars and reasons for decision

Details of your request were provided to the Finance Section within An Garda Síochána who conducted a search for records relating to your request.
