## Re: Freedom of Information Request FOI-000173-2015

#### Dear

I refer to the Freedom of Information Act 2014 and your submission to An Garda Síochána dated 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2015 and received on the 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2015.

Part 1 of Schedule 1 of the Freedom of Information Act 2014 states that An Garda Síochána is listed as a partially included agency "insofar as it relates to administrative records relating to human resources, or finance or procurement matters". Therefore, only administrative records that relate to human resources, finance or procurement shall be considered.

Your request is shown below:

I would like to apply under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act for the following records held by the Garda:

Copy of briefing material prepared for the Garda officers who appeared before the joint Oireachtas Committee on Transport, Sport and Tourism on Wednesday, November, 25th,

I understand a member of staff from this office spoke to you with regard to your request and advised you that the minutes from this particular Committee meeting were available on the Oireachtas webstie. However you advised that you are anxious to pursue with your request.

I now wish to inform you that your request has been **refused**.

### 1. Findings, particulars and reasons for decisions to deny access

As previously advised, An Garda Síochána is a partially included agency under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 "insofar as it relates to administrative records relating to human resources, or finance or procurement matters". After reviewing your request, I have decided that the information you have sought including briefing material prepared for Garda officers who appeared before the

Joint Oireachtas Committee, refers to operational policing matters and falls outside these areas. Therefore, the records sought by you fall outside the scope of the Act.

## 2. Rights of appeal
