How many speeding notices by way of fixed charge notice are issued?

How many speeding summonses, both by gardai and when the fixed charge notice is not paid, are issued?

How many are paid?

U am trying to track what happens foreign drivers caught speeding on Irish Roads. Are EU drivers chased for fines and are rental car companies?

I wish to inform you that I have decided to <u>refuse</u> your request on the 1st September, 2016.

1. Findings, particulars and reasons for decisions.

Part 1(n) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act states that An Garda Síochána is listed as a partially included agency "insofar as it relates to administrative records relating to human resources, or finance or procurement matters". Therefore, only administrative records that relate to human resources, finance or procurement shall be considered.
