## Re: Freedom of Information Request FOI-000372-2016 Refused

Part 1(n) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act states that An Garda Síochána is listed as a partially included agency "insofar as it relates to administrative records relating to human resources, or finance or procurement matters". Therefore, only administrative records that relate to human resources, finance or procurement shall be considered.

#### Your request sought:

all records, including emails, correspondence, minutes of meetings, planning documents and any other relevant documents, relating to the number of holding cells, the usage of these cells particularly in relation to overcrowding and time spent in cells, holding cell size, holding cell conditions, and facilities available to persons held in these cells, and whether these cells meet Irish, European, and International standards

I also request that all records, including emails, correspondence, minutes of meetings, planning documents and any other relevant documents to above, be organised by year, county, and Garda Station.

I also request all records, including emails, correspondence, minutes of meetings and any other relevant documents, relating to discussions with the Irish Prison Service, Court Service, Minister for, and Department of, Justice and Equality, about the above issues.

The purpose of this letter is to explain my decision.

## 1. Findings, particulars and reasons for decision.

Part 1(n) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act states that An Garda Síochána is listed as a partially included agency "insofar as it relates to administrative records relating to human resources, or finance or procurement matters". Therefore, only administrative records that relate to human resources, finance or procurement shall be considered. Your request is in relation to an operational policing matter which does not come within the ambit of this partially included agency as set out in Part 1(n) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act.

I am therefore refusing your request as it is falls outside the scope of the FOI Act insofar as it pertains to An Garda Síochána.
