# Re: Freedom of Information Request FOI-000434-2016 Request Refused

#### Dear

I refer to your request, dated and received on the 30<sup>th</sup> November 2016 which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 (FOI Act) for records held by An Garda Síochána.

Part 1(n) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act states that An Garda Síochána is listed as a partially included agency "insofar as it relates to administrative records relating to human resources, or finance or procurement matters". Therefore, only administrative records that relate to human resources, finance or procurement shall be considered

#### Your request sought:

- 1. Who is the details of your Force Lead for Digital Policing?
- 2. How many intelligence analysts does your Force employ?
- 3. How many Body Worn Videos/Cameras does your Force have?
- 4. How many officers/staff does your Force have who are trained in Facial Recognition?
- 5. How many officers/staff does your Force have who are trained in Predictive Analysis?
- 6. How many officers/staff does your Force have who are trained in Crime Mapping?
- 7. How many warranted officers does your Force employ.

I wish to inform you that I have decided to <u>refuse</u> your request on the 8<sup>th</sup> December, 2016.

The purpose of this letter is to explain my decision.

## 1. Findings, particulars and reasons for decision.

Part 1(n) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act states that An Garda Síochána is listed as a partially included agency "insofar as it relates to administrative records relating to human resources, or finance or procurement matters". Therefore, only administrative records that relate to human resources, finance or procurement shall be considered. Your request is seeking information pertaining to operational Garda matters and is not considered an <u>administrative</u> record and does not come within the ambit of this partially included agency as set out in Part 1(n) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act.

I am therefore refusing your request as it is outside the scope of the FOI Act insofar as it pertains to An Garda Síochána.

With regard to question 7 of your request I can tell you that this information is published in the Garda Síochána Annual report which is available at the link below. <a href="http://garda.ie/Controller.aspx?Page=16448&Lang=1">http://garda.ie/Controller.aspx?Page=16448&Lang=1</a>. As the information is already in the public domain on an annual basis section 15(1)(d) of the FOI Act, which is shown below, is relevant.
