Re: Freedom of Information Request FOI-000015-2015 Request Refusal

Dear

I refer to the Freedom of Information Act 2014 and your submission to this body dated 14/10/2015 and received on 14/10/2015.

Part 1 of Schedule 1 of the Freedom of Information Act 2014 states that An Garda Síochána is listed as a partially included agency "insofar as it relates to administrative records relating to human resources, or finance or procurement matters". Therefore, only administrative records that relate to human resources, finance or procurement shall be considered.

Your request is shown below:

"I wish to request, under the Freedom of Information Act, details of how many serving gardai have criminal records and a breakdown of these convictions as of the day of this request."

I, wish to inform you that your request has been refused.

The purpose of this letter is to explain my decision.

1. Findings, particulars and reasons for decision

I am refusing your request on the basis that the records are not readily identifiable and it would cause a substantial and unreasonable disruption in Human Resources and People Development of An Garda Síochána to inspect all manual discipline records held to identify the information for this query.

Section 15(1)(c) of the Freedom of Information Act 2014 is as follows:

- 15. (1) A head to whom an FOI request is made may refuse to grant the request where—
 - (c) in the opinion of the head, granting the request would, by reason of the number or nature of the records concerned or the nature of the information concerned, require the retrieval and examination of such number of records or an examination of such kind of the records concerned as to cause a substantial and unreasonable interference with or disruption of work (including disruption of work in a particular functional area) of the FOI body concerned,

With reference to your request I wish to make you aware that the policy of Human Resources and People Development is that they are made aware of incidents where court proceedings are, or about to be instituted by An Garda Síochána against a member of An Garda Síochána. The information regarding convictions received by Gardaí is stored manually and not in a centralised manner that would allow for easy retrieval. It should be noted that the reporting of prosecutions against Gardaí is an internal policy and does not apply to Departments that initiate and prosecute their own cases. The best source of comprehensive data regarding convictions is the Court Services.

In accordance with the requirements of section 15(1)(c) of the Freedom of Information Act 2014 I am refusing your request.

2. Right of appeal

In the event that you are not happy with this decision you may seek an Internal Review of the matter by writing to the address below and quoting reference number F01-000015-2015.

The making of a late appeal may be permitted in appropriate circumstances.
