Request Refusal

Dear

I refer to the Freedom of Information Act 2014 and your submission to this body dated 16/10/2015 and received on 16/10/2015.

Part 1 of Schedule 1 of the Freedom of Information Act 2014 states that An Garda Síochána is listed as a partially included agency “*insofar as it relates to administrative records relating to human resources, or finance or procurement matters*”. Therefore, only administrative records that relate to human resources, finance or procurement shall be considered.

Your request is shown below:

“Under the FOI Act, can I get all correspondence between Noírin O’Sullivan since her appointment as Garda Commissioner and the Minister for Justice which relates to the need for an increase in Garda numbers”

I, _____ wish to inform you that your request **has been refused**.

The purpose of this letter is to explain my decision.

1. Findings, particulars and reasons for decision

The Garda Commissioner was appointed on 25th November 2014. Correspondence between the Garda Commissioner and the Minister for Justice and Equality was queried in response to this request. From conversations held with the staff of the Commissioner’s office I am satisfied that all

correspondence is held electronically The search was conducted across the electronic correspondence recorded in the Commissioner's Office to identify records which had key words in the title such as "Garda Numbers". Any records identified were searched for references to the term "Minister". No records were located.

In addition to the above search the correspondence between the Garda Commissioner and the Minister for Justice and Equality was queried from October 2014 to October 2015. The following key words were used to search the system: HR, Human Resources and Staffing. Any records identified, using the key word search, were further searched for references to the term "Minister". No records were identified.

As no records were located you may wish to reconsider your search criterion and provide a more specific search relevant to the information you seek. My office can assist you as necessary.

In accordance with the requirements of section 15(1) (a), I am satisfied that all reasonable steps have been taken to identify and locate the records requested in relation to your request. As the records concerned could not be located I must therefore refuse your request on this basis.

2. Right of appeal

In the event that you are not happy with this decision you may seek an Internal Review of the matter by writing to the address below and quoting reference number **FOI-000052-2015**.

You should submit your request for an Internal Review within 20 working days from the date of this notification. A working day excludes the weekend and public holidays. The review will involve a complete reconsideration of the matter by a more senior member of An Garda Síochána and the

decision will be communicated to you within 3 weeks. The making of a late appeal may be permitted in appropriate circumstances.
