Dear.

I refer to your request, dated and received on the 11th July 2016 which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 (FOI Act) for records held by An Garda Síochána.

Part 1(n) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act states that An Garda Síochána is listed as a partially included agency "insofar as it relates to administrative records relating to human resources, or finance or procurement matters". Therefore, only administrative records that relate to human resources, finance or procurement shall be considered.

Your request sought:

1) I would like to know how many new recruits have been assigned to each of the three Cork Garda Divisions between Jan 1, 2015 and Dec 31, 2015 and also for the period Jan 1, 2016 to June 30, 2016.

I have decided to grant your request on the 2nd of August 2016.

The purpose of this letter is to explain that decision.

1. Findings, particulars and reasons for decision

The table below outlines the number of probationer Gardaí allocated to each of the three Cork Garda Divisions within the time-frames requested:

Garda Division	01/01/2015 — 31/12/2015	01/01/2016 — 30/06/2016
Cork City	5	3
Cork North	0	0
Cork West	0	0

Garda personnel assigned throughout the country, together with overall policing arrangements and operational strategy, are continually monitored and reviewed. The assignment of Garda personnel is determined by a number of factors including population, crime trends and as the policing needs of each individual Garda Division dictates. Such monitoring ensures that optimum use is made of Garda resources, and the best possible Garda service is provided to the general public.

A distribution model is utilised in the deployment of Garda personnel which takes into account all relevant factors including population, crime trends and the individual policing needs of the Division. It is the responsibility of the Divisional Officer to allocate personnel within his/her Division.

2. Right of Appeal
