I refer to the Freedom of Information Act 2014 and your submission to An Garda Síochána dated and received on 25th October 2016.

Part 1(n) of Scheudle 1 of the Freedom of Information Act 2014 states that An Garda Síochána is listed as a partially included agency "insofar as it relates to administrative records relating to human resources, or finance or procurement matters". Therefore, only administrative records that relate to human resources, finance or procurement shall be considered.

Your request is shown below:-

I have now made a final decision to partially-grant your request on 22nd November 2016.

The purpose of this letter is to explain that decision.
