




IF YOU ARE TRAVELLING SHORTLY...

Visit www.passportappointments.ie to make an appointment and submit the application in person at our Passport Offices in Dublin or Cork.

Please note that the number of appointments available each week is limited. You should not seek to make an appointment if you have already submitted a passport application.

IF YOU ARE TRAVELLING FOR EMERGENCY PURPOSES

Passports can also be issued at short notice but only in **strictly emergency situations** such as the death or serious illness of a family member abroad or where urgent medical treatment is needed.

Applicants will need to produce written proof of the emergency situation and should submit the application in person at our Passport Offices in Dublin or Cork.
