

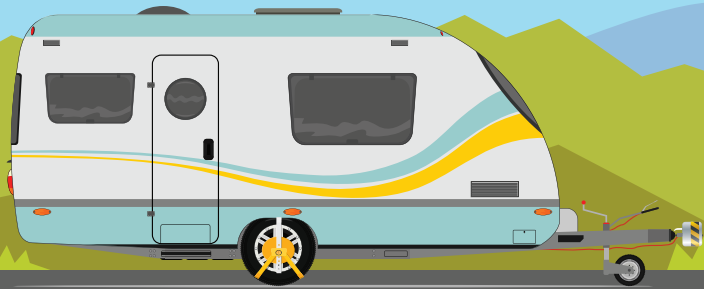


# CARAVAN SECURITY

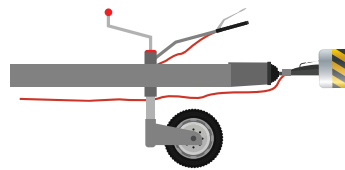

## ALARM

Get an alarm fitted if one is not already in place.



## HITCH/WHEEL LOCK

Ensure a hitch lock and wheel clamps are in place (good quality) and that the caravan is locked to a secure point.



## TRACKING

A tracking device will increase the chance of recovering the caravan if it is stolen.



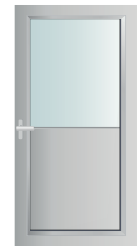
## PROPERTY

Keep valuables out of sight and remove when not in use.



## COVER

Use a cover when not in use. This may deter thieves as pulling off a cover can be noisy and add to the time taken to steal the caravan.



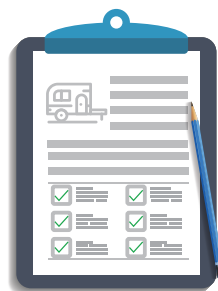
## WINDOWS & DOORS

Ensure windows and doors are locked.



## LIGHTING

Park in a well-lit area. Keep a light on if leaving unattended overnight.



## RECORD

Keep good records of all serial numbers, unique markings etc. Keep documents secure.



Consider voluntarily registering your caravan with the Central Registration and Identification Scheme (CRIS).
