YOUR SAFETY

- Do not bring backpacks or large handbags – A4 size only. No cloakroom or storage facilities at event. For security reasons any items left unattended will be removed and disposed.
- Outdoor event. Event will take place rain or shine. Please check weather conditions and dress appropriately, but remember No umbrellas!
- Please plan your journey to the event in advance and allow at least 1.5 hours extra travel time.
- Have your ticket ready for inspection on approach roads to the event.
- Everyone will be subject to a search permissible under law and a condition of ticket purchase and entry
- No glass or cans, hard reusable water bottles/flasks, umbrellas, alcohol, garden furniture, camping/ folding chairs, selfie sticks, flares, sparklers etc. are permitted.
- No professional cameras or cameras with a detachable lens, video cameras & audio recording devices, iPads or Go Pros.
- Obey the stewards and Gardaí and instructions given for your own safety.
- Don't rush to exits after the gig. Allow an extra 20 mins to exit the event.
- There are no re-admissions to the venue. If you leave, there is no re-entry.
- The Event Organisers and An Garda Síochána reserve the right to refuse admission to anyone under

the influence of alcohol/illegal substance.

- The Garda Síochána will have a traffic management and security plan in operation for information visit *www.garda.ie*.
- Additional security checks of clothing, bags and other items as determined by Organisers and An Garda Síochána will be undertaken.

- Organisers do not operate transportation to or from the venue which is matter for all customers to plan and arrange in advance.

 – LUAS, DART, Taxi, Irish Rail or Dublin Bus.
- For those who must drive, there will be limited parking available in the Point Village car park. This is run by Euro Car Parks and can be booked in advance via Ticketmaster for the concert only. Pre-booking parking for the matinee show is not possible.
