



MCD concerts at Royal Hospital Kilmainham 2026

Dear Resident,

We at MCD are writing to inform you that we will be producing three concerts on the 20th, 21st & 25th of August 2026 on the grounds of the Irish Museum of Modern Art, Royal Hospital Kilmainham, Dublin. Works will commence on site on the evening of the 11th August and will finish by 30th August. Normal working hours will be from 08:00 hrs – 23:00 hrs. *(subject to change)*

Please Note:

- Soundchecks may take place on 19th and 24th between 11:00 – 20:00hrs as well as show days up until 17.00hrs and be limited in duration to no more than three hours total cumulative duration per day.

Please note:

- Dog walking will be available outside the site perimeter in the meadow during the period 12th Aug to 28th August. On show days, 20th, 21st & 25th of August dog walking is permitted until 14:00. Entry will only be from the West side of the meadow.
- The West gate will close on show days at 14:00.
- On show days, museum visitors must enter via the East gate from Military Road. Last entry at 17:15 for both pedestrians and vehicles.
- There will be a one-way system in place from 15:30 on show days in and out of the car park, please allow for some possible delays.

The event organisers have been liaising with all relevant statutory agencies including An Garda Síochána, Dublin City Council, the HSE, Dublin Fire Service, Transdev/Luas and Dublin Bus to ensure that a robust event management plan is in place and that any disruption to the local neighbourhood and surrounding areas is kept to a minimum, insofar as is possible while holding an event of this nature.

- MCD have contracted the services of an independent Noise Monitoring Consultant to ensure that sound levels do not exceed the limits contained within the License. Noise levels will be monitored inside the venue as well as in local surrounding area.

- The venue will be secured and patrolled by An Garda Síochána and an experienced and licensed security company.
- There will be a comprehensive litter management plan in operation both inside and outside the venue and the areas surrounding the venue will be returned to an as-found condition the following morning.
- MCD encourage all ticketholders to use public transport or private coach services. No concert parking will be permitted on residential streets.

Garda Traffic Management Plan:

- Military Road will be closed to inbound traffic only from the junction with John's Road West from 16:00hrs on the 20th, 21st & 25th August 2026. All traffic exiting HSQ onto Military Road will be directed left toward St Johns Road West.
- Bow Lane West junction with James St will be closed to vehicular traffic with the exception of Local access for residents residing on Bow Lane West, Irwin St, Kilmainham Lane and Staff of the Walter Scott House on Military Road & Staff of RHK from 16:00hrs on the 20th, 21st & 25th August 2026.
- Access to HSQ will be available from St Johns Road West entrance.
- Kilmainham Lane will be local access only (No Through traffic) from 16:00hrs on 20th, 21st & 25th August 2026. Use of barriers, cones and Garda presence will enforce road closures.
- Cars displaying a disability badge will be permitted to use the East Gate to access the event.
- If clarification on any traffic issues is required, please call Kilmainham Garda Station on 01 666 9700
- Further temporary restrictions will be implemented on St Johns Road West & South Circular Road during egress only.

While we endeavour to ensure disruption is kept to a minimum, we will be available should you require additional assistance.
