Policing Plan 2023 is the second of three annual plans set out to realise the objectives of our Strategy Statement and support the achievement of our central mission.

The priorities outlined in Policing Plan 2023 include strengthening community partnerships, proactively preventing, disrupting and detecting crime, supporting the needs of victims, and safeguarding the security of the State.

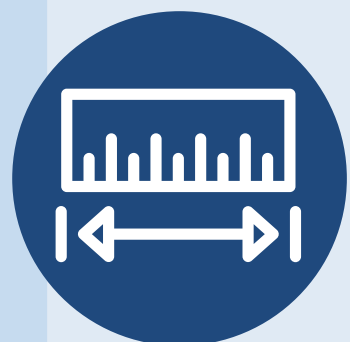
As a citizen, some of the specific activities that you will see progressed in 2023 will include:



Finalising the rollout of the **Community Policing Framework** - The Community Policing Framework provides a methodology through which quality of life issues for our communities, relevant to the role of An Garda Síochána, are addressed in partnership with appropriate agencies, community groups etc.



The launch of our **Equality, Diversity and Inclusion strategy**, along with the rollout of cultural and diversity awareness training, will enable the organisation to deliver a policing service that recognises the diversity of the people we serve



Implementing a system of **outcomes-based measurement** for all crime types – This will provide insight into why a sanction wasn’t achieved and provide rich data for victims, stakeholders and policy formation



The Rollout of **GardaSAFE emergency response system** – This system will support our commitment to victims and ensure that instant and vital information is provided to Gardaí on the frontline when responding to calls



Rolling out the **Operating Model** at Regional, National and Divisional level – The roll out of the Operating Model will see consistent service delivery across Garda Divisions with processes and operations that support frontline community policing

The work that An Garda Síochána will progress in 2023 will ensure that we can continue to have strong engagement with our local, national and international partners to prevent, disrupt, detect and investigate all crime types, to enhance the safety of our roads and to address harm in the communities we serve.
