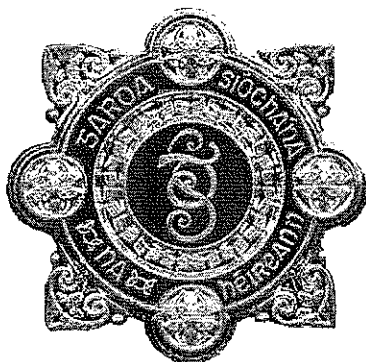

The D.M.R. East Garda Division Policing Plan is based upon the six strategic goals set out in the DMR Policing Plan 2008 and the National Policing Plan 2008. This is the second year of a three year cycle towards the implementation of the Garda Síochána Corporate Strategy 2007-2009. An Garda Síochána's Corporate Strategy 2007-2009 sets out the Vision, Mission, Values and Strategic Imperatives which is the foundation on which we will pursue our Strategic Goals. Within that framework the D.M.R. East Garda Division Policing Plan sets out the priorities for the policing of this Division over the next 12 months.



Policing Plans for Dun Laoghaire (F), Bray (N) and Blackrock (W) Garda Districts are drawn up using the framework of the Divisional, Regional and National Policing Plans with particular emphasis placed on their specific District needs.
