## FOREWORD FROM THE DONEGAL DIVISIONAL OFFICER.

This Donegal Division Policing Plan for 2008 represents the goals of An Garda Síochána in Donegal division for 2008 with a view to attaining the vision set out in An Garda Síochána Corporate Strategy 2007-2009. There continues to be significant change in the structures of An Garda Síochána and in particular, there will be a significant increase in the level of civilian support staff and members of the Garda Reserve supporting operational units throughout the division in 2008. There will also be significant changes in administration throughout the Garda organisation in 2008 which will pose ongoing challenges for the organisation.



An Garda Síochána in Donegal will continue strict enforcement of road traffic legislation and mandatory alcohol breath testing with a view to minimising the number of fatal and serious traffic collisions on the roads in Donegal.

One of my principle goals is to significantly reduce the level of public disorder on the streets of the villages and towns of Donegal during this year. I expect all licensees to co-operate with An Garda Síochána reducing incidents of public drunkenness. Such behaviour is socially unacceptable and we have a collective responsibility to work together to curb it. There will be early intervention by Gardaí to ensure that drunkenness is not tolerated. Drugs are also a significant cause of public disorder and An Garda Síochána will continue to be steadfast in curtailing the activities of drug dealers and to increase enforcement of the Misuse of Drugs Act.

An Garda Síochána will actively implement an improved accountability framework with participation in Joint Policing Committees and other Local Policing Fora. All Community Alert and Neighbourhood Watch schemes will be reviewed during the year and corrective action will be taken where appropriate to ensure that all such schemes are active and worthwhile. I also intend to increase the number of Gardaí attached to community policing units throughout the division to ensure that An Garda Síochána is more visible and accessible to the community in general.

On the accommodation front, it is intended to acquire Garda accommodation on Arranmore island as well as upgrade the accommodation at Carndonagh. A Divisional Traffic Corps will be established in Dunfanaghy to cover Milford and Glenties districts while it is proposed to develop a regional traffic training facility at the old Garda station in Ballyshannon. A divisional property and exhibits store and a purpose built custody suite will be installed in Letterkenny station.

Policing, by its nature, is always evolving and a policing plan must be flexible enough to allow for any contingency that may arise. I would appreciate the views of the general public and other stakeholders on this policing plan. I will be happy to consider any submissions on this plan with a view to improving this plan and future plans. My Divisional Garda Team remain fully committed to delivering the highest standards of Policing within Donegal.
