

- National/International Security To maintain National and International Security through a secure democracy and response capability benchmarked against best international practice.
- 2. *Crime* To significantly reduce the incidence of crime and criminal behaviour by reducing overall crime by 2% and increasing the detection rate by 2%.
- 3. **Traffic and Road Safety** To significantly reduce the incidence of fatal and serious injuries and improve road safety by reducing fatal & serious injury traffic collisions in line with Government Road Strategy.
- 4. **Public Order** To significantly reduce the incidence of public disorder and anti-social behaviour in our communities by reducing the number of youths involved in crime and increasing the Garda satisfaction rate by 2%.
