RULES OF THE COMPETITION



1. Awards are confined to those young people who are aged between 13 and 21 years on 31st July 2024.
2. Permanent residence of the young person must be in the Cavan Monaghan Garda area.
3. Awards are confined to individuals and groups of two or more people.
4. Judges decision is final.
5. The Judging Panel will decide upon one nominee in each category to go forward to represent the Division at the National Garda Youth Awards. Details of these nominees will be passed on to the Judging Panel of the Garda National Youth Awards.
6. Details of all nominees will be retained for a period not exceeding 6 months after the closing date, at which time details will be destroyed, in compliance with General Data Protection Regulations.
7. Any member of the public may nominate anyone whom they feel deserves an award.
8. Nominations may be submitted by family members or relatives.
9. Previous award winners are not eligible.

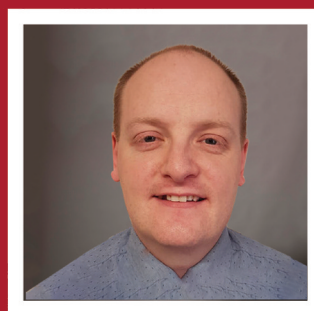

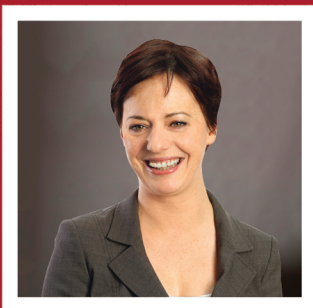

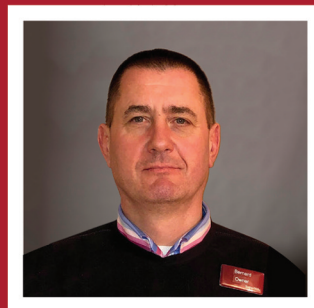
