# Re: Freedom of Information Request FOI-000071-2018 Request Granted

#### Dear

I refer to your request, dated and received on the 7<sup>th</sup> February, 2018 which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 (FOI Act) for records held by An Garda Síochána.

Part 1(n) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act states that An Garda Síochána is listed as a partially included agency "insofar as it relates to administrative records relating to human resources, or finance or procurement matters". Therefore, only administrative records that relate to human resources, finance or procurement shall be considered.

### Your request sought:

I am seeking the release of the number of internal complaints made to the HR Department of AGS over bullying and sexual harassment since 2015, with details of any further action taken and a year by year breakdown of the figure.

## Clarified Request 14th February 2018

I can confirm that my request is specifically in relation to Garda members of AGS.

I wish to inform you that I have decided to grant your request on the 16th February, 2018.

The purpose of this letter is to explain that decision.

#### 1. Findings, particulars and reasons for decision

Details of your FOI request were provided to the Human Resource Management (HRM) section of An Garda Síochána. HRM have provided records to this Office in response to your request.

Upon review of the records, I have decided to grant your request and a copy is outlined in the table below. The figures provided refer to complaints made by Garda members against Garda colleagues as requested on 14<sup>th</sup> February 2018.

In relation to Civilian members The Dignity at Work — and anti-bullying, harassment and sexual harassment policy for the Irish Civil Service, issued by the Department Public Expenditure and Reform, is a Civil Service wide policy which is applied to civilian staff working within An Garda Síochána.
