Re: Freedom of Information Request FOI-000212-2018 Request Part-Granted

Dear

I refer to your request, dated and received on 22nd May 2018 which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 (FOI Act) for records held by An Garda Síochána.

Part 1(n) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act states that An Garda Síochána is listed as a partially included agency "*insofar as it relates to administrative records relating to human resources, or finance or procurement matters*". Therefore, only administrative records that relate to human resources, finance or procurement shall be considered.

Your request sought:

Materials showing how many gardai are in Cork city and the number of those who have up to date CBD2 driving training, and the number of garda in the past two years who had an incident while in pursuit of a vehicle when driving with CBD1 training.

I wish to inform you that I have decided to part-grant your request on the 14th June 2018.

The purpose of this letter is to explain that decision.

1. Findings, particulars and reasons for decision

Upon receipt, your request was forwarded to the Human Resource Management Section of An Garda Síochána and a search was conducted in this regard.

In the first part of your request you sought ‘*how many gardai are in Cork city*’. I can advise you that there was 682 members attached to Cork City as of 30th April 2018.

The second part of your request sought ‘*the number of those who have up to date CBD2 driving training*’. Following consultation with the Garda College in this regard, I can now advise you that 330 have up to date CBD2 driving training in Cork City:

The last part of your request sought ‘*the number of garda in the past two years who had an incident while in pursuit of a vehicle when driving with CBD1 training*’.

Section 6(2)(a) of the FOI Act provides that an entity specified in Schedule 1, Part 1 of the Act shall, subject to the provisions of that Part, be a public body for the purposes of the FOI Act. Schedule 1, Part 1 contains details of bodies that are partially included for the purposes of the FOI Act and also details of the certain specified records that are excluded. If the records sought come within the description of the exclusions of Part 1, then the FOI Act does not apply and no right of access exists.

Part 1(n) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act provides that An Garda Síochána is not a public body for the purposes of the FOI Act other than in relation to administrative records relating to human resources, or finance or procurement matters.

The term “administrative records” is understood to mean records relating to the processes of running and managing a business or organisation. As a result, the FOI Act excludes operational policing business as opposed to the defined administrative processes of An Garda Síochána.

In this regard, I am refusing to provide this information as it falls outside the scope of the FOI Act insofar as the records do not meet the criteria of administrative records as defined in the Act.

2. Right of Appeal

In the event that you are not happy with this decision you may seek an Internal Review of the matter by writing to the address below and quoting reference number **FOI-000212-2018**.

You should submit your request for an Internal Review within 4 weeks from the date of this notification. The review will involve a complete reconsideration of the matter by a more senior member of An Garda Síochána and the decision will be communicated to you within 3 weeks. The making of a late appeal may be permitted in appropriate circumstances.
