Dear

I refer to your request, dated and received on 22nd February, 2022 which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 (FOI Act) for records held by An Garda Síochána.

Part 1(n) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act states that An Garda Síochána is listed as a partially included agency "*insofar as it relates to administrative records relating to human resources, or finance or procurement matters*". Therefore, only administrative records that relate to human resources, finance or procurement shall be considered.

Your request sought:

I was wondering if you would tell me the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2014

- 1) The number of full time Garda civilian staff by grade working in each Garda station within the Dublin Region as of 18 February 2022 in tabular form*

I wish to inform you that I have decided to grant your request on the 9th March 2022.

The purpose of this letter is to explain my decision.

1. Findings, particulars and reasons for decision.

Upon receipt, your request was forwarded to the relevant sections of An Garda Síochána where searches were conducted in respect of same. The table below details the current civilian staffing broken down by grade in Garda Stations within the Dublin Region.
