Dear

I refer to your request, dated 6th March, 2023 and received on 7th March, 2023 which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 (FOI Act) for records held by An Garda Síochána.

Part 1(n) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act states that An Garda Síochána is listed as a partially included agency "insofar as it relates to administrative records relating to human resources, or finance or procurement matters". Therefore, only administrative records that relate to human resources, finance or procurement shall be considered.

Your request sought:

I would like to make a FOI request under the Freedom of Information Act 2014. Under section 7 of this act, I would like access to the records held by An Garda Síochána. The information I am seeking relates the road traffic enforcement fines revenue relating to the R830 Kill Lane, Dublin.

In excel or pdf format, I am seeking the monthly monetary amount of all Fixed Charge Notices issued by An Garda Síochána on this road from 1 November 2022 to 28 February 2023, broken down by offence group (if possible).

1. Findings, particulars and reasons for decision

Upon receipt your request was forwarded to the relevant Section of An Garda Síochána who have provided records to this office in response to your request. The tables below detail the

breakdown of revenue and the number of offences issued for Kill Lane from the 1st November 2022 to the 28th February 2023. Please be advised that the records provided are based upon operational data from the FCPS system as on 14.03.2023 and is liable to change.
