Dear

I refer to your request, dated and received on 15th April, 2019 which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 (FOI Act) for records held by An Garda Síochána.

Part 1(n) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act states that An Garda Síochána is listed as a partially included agency "insofar as it relates to administrative records relating to human resources, or finance or procurement matters". Therefore, only administrative records that relate to human resources, finance or procurement shall be considered.

Your request sought:

The number of vehicle technicians, collision repair technician, motorcycle technicians and HGV Technicians employed by An Garda Síochána as of 31 December 2017, 31 December 2018 and 12 April 2019 in tabular form.

I wish to inform you that I have decided to grant your request on the 7th May, 2019.

The purpose of this letter is to explain my decision.

1. Findings, particulars and reason for decisions.

Upon receipt of your request, the relevant sections of An Garda Síochána were contacted to retrieve the information. We have been advised that An Garda Síochána operates a fleet management model based on professional industry standards. All service, repairs and bodywork repairs are contracted as per tenders published through the Office of Public Procurement and are outsourced. The table below provides the details of the numbers of Vehicle Technicians employed in the requested years.
