I refer to your request, dated and received on 9th June, 2020 which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 (FOI Act) for records held by An Garda Síochána.

Part 1(n) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act states that An Garda Síochána is listed as a partially included agency "insofar as it relates to administrative records relating to human resources, or finance or procurement matters". Therefore, only administrative records that relate to human resources, finance or procurement shall be considered.

Your request sought:

I am seeking the following under the Freedom of Information Act -

The amount spent by the Gardai from the start of March to date on equipment to deal with Covid 19.

The amount paid by the Gardai to named third parties for named goods (and their quantity) in response to Covid 19

I wish to inform you that I have decided to part grant your request on 26th June, 2020.

The purpose of this letter is to explain my decision.

1. Findings, particulars and reasons for decision

On receipt your request was forwarded to the Finance Division of An Garda Síochána who conducted a search for records in respect of your request. An Garda Síochána has purchased significant amounts of protective equipment and supplies. This equipment has been sourced in order to protect Garda members and Staff as well as members of the public they interact with during this time. I can advise that to date €12,947,669 has been spent on Covid-19 related equipment. A list of the equipment purchased and the quantities purchased are attached.

Section 36 – Commercial Sensitive Information

I am refusing the release of records detailing the amounts paid to suppliers in accordance with Section 36 (1)(b) of the Act

- (1) Subject to subsection (2) a head shall refuse to grant an FOI request if the record concerned contains
 - (b) financial, commercial, scientific or technical or other information whose disclosure could reasonably be expected to result in a material financial loss or gain to the person to whom the information relates, or could prejudice the competitive position of that person in the conduct of his or her profession or business or otherwise in his or her occupation'

This exemption is being used to protect the companies whose commercially sensitive information is held in the enclosed records, for the provision of their services to An Garda Síochána. I am satisfied that the release of the amounts paid to suppliers along with quantities purchased could prejudice the competitive position of the suppliers by making the cost per unit publically known. This information therefore is commercially sensitive in accordance with the provisions of section 36 of the FOI Act.

I am cognisant of the fact that the release of information under the Act is, in essence, a release to the public at large. The pricing structure of the suppliers with regard to the services provided to An Garda Síochána is not known to competitors or the public in general. If the records were made available to you, it is reasonable to expect that it would prejudice the ability of the suppliers to compete in other contracts or negotiations in the future.

I am of the view that the release of the pricing structure could reasonably be expected to result in a material financial loss by the suppliers as it could prejudice their competitive position in the conduct of their business. The placing of these pricing structures into the public domain could also reasonably be expected to give a competitive advantage to other companies seeking similar contracts with public bodies.

I am satisfied that the release of the details involved could prejudice the competitive position of the companies named in the records provided and is commercially sensitive due to the fact that it exposes the fee structure of these companies.

As per section 36 of the FOI Act, I have considered the public interest issues which arise in this case and have taken account of the following factors in favour of release

- Ensuring openness and transparency of organisational functions to the greatest possible extent,
- The public interest in members of the public exercising their rights under the FOI Act,
- That there is more than just a transitory interest by the public in this information,
- Ensuring openness and transparency in the expenditure of public funds.

In considering the public interest factors which favour withholding the records, I have taken account of the following:

- The public interest is not best served by releasing these records,
- That the Organisation can conduct its business in a confidential manner,
- Protecting the vital interests of the business community,
- In not preventing or impeding a company from the effective pursuit of their legitimate business.

Having balanced the public interest factors both for and against the release, I decided that the public interest in preserving the information and the reasonable expectation that information can be maintained by An Garda Síochána without prejudicing future financial endeavors by external service providers outweighs the public interest which would be served were the records released to you.

I also have considered the provisions of section 36(2) and decided that they do not have any bearing on the decision as the overriding interest is to protect the sensitive commercial and financial information in this case.

2. Right of Appeal

The review will involve a complete reconsideration of the matter by a more senior member of An Garda Síochána and the decision will be communicated to you within 3 weeks. The making of a late appeal may be permitted in appropriate circumstances.
