I would also like a breakdown by gender of all of the above stats.
- The number of complaints of workplace sexual harassment of gardaí received by An Garda Síochána in (i) 2016, (ii) 2017, (iii) 2018 and (iv) so far in 2019 along with the number of these (in each year) that were sent forward for investigation, and the number of which resulted in disciplinary action, and information on the nature of the disciplinary action. I would also like a breakdown by gender of all of the above stats.
