## Re: Freedom of Information Request FOI-000063-2024 Request Part-granted

#### Dear

I refer to your request, dated and received on 12<sup>th</sup> February, 2024 which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 (FOI Act) for records held by An Garda Síochána.

Part 1(n) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act states that An Garda Síochána is listed as a partially included agency "insofar as it relates to administrative records relating to human resources, or finance or procurement matters". Therefore, only administrative records that relate to human resources, finance or procurement shall be considered.

#### Your request sought:

- The number of Garda identification cards reported lost by members of AGS from 23 September 2022 to 31 December 2022.
- The number of Garda identification cards reported lost by members of AGS in 2023.
- The number of Garda firearms reported lost by members of AGS from 2019-2023.

I wish to inform you that I have decided to part-grant your request on the 27th February 2024.

The purpose of this letter is to explain that decision.

### 1. Findings, particulars and reasons for decision

Upon receipt, your request was forwarded to the relevant section of An Garda Síochána to retrieve the information requested by you and a number of records have been identified.

In response to Part 1 & 2 of your request, there were 44 Garda Identification cards reported lost by members of An Garda Síochána from 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2022 to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2022 and 138 reported lost by members of An Garda Síochána in 2023.

I am refusing the last part of your request regarding, "the number of Garda firearms reported lost by members in AGS", on the basis that this Act does not apply to a record held or created by An Garda Síochána that relates to the Emergency Response Unit, The Special Detective Unit and the Security and Intelligence Sections as outlined below:

#### Restriction of the Act.

Section 42 refers to the restrictions included in the FOI Act with regard to records that are exempt for release by An Garda Síochána.

In this regard, a number of records are refused under Section 42 (b) wherein it states that:

## Restriction of Act

- 42. This Act does not apply to—
  - (b) a record held or created by the Garda Siochána that relates to any of the following:
    - (i) the Emergency Response Unit;
    - (ii) the Secret Service Fund maintained by it;
    - (iii) the Special Detective Unit (SDU);
    - (iv) the witness protection programme sponsored by it;
    - (v) the Security and Intelligence Section;
    - (vi) the management and use of covert intelligence operations;
    - (vii) the Interception of Postal Packets and Telecommunications Messages (Regulation) Act 1993;
    - (viii) the Criminal Justice (Terrorist Offences) Act 2005;
    - (ix) the Criminal Justice (Surveillance) Act 2009;
    - (x) the Communications (Retention of Data) Act 2011:

In accordance with the requirements of Section 42 of the Freedom of Information Act 2014 I am refusing this part of your request.

## 2. Right of Appeal
