I refer to your request, dated and received on 3rd September, 2021 which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 (FOI Act) for records held by An Garda Síochána.

Part 1(n) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act states that An Garda Síochána is listed as a partially included agency "insofar as it relates to administrative records relating to human resources, or finance or procurement matters". Therefore, only administrative records that relate to human resources, finance or procurement shall be considered.

Your request sought:

I wish to apply under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 for the following information relating to finance/procurement

- 1. The amount spent by AGS at shooting ranges in each of the years 2010 to 2021
- 2. The names of shooting ranges where AGS expenditure occurred

I wish to inform you that I have decided to part-grant your request on 30th September, 2021.

The purpose of this letter is to explain my decision in respect of each part of your request.

1. Findings, particulars and reasons for decision

Details of your request were provided to the Finance Directorate of An Garda Síochána who conducted a search for records in relation to your request.

I have been advised that following a search of the Financial Management System, no records have been identified in respect of the information sought by you for the years 2010 to 2013.

Therefore, I wish to advise that I am refusing this part of your request in accordance with Section 15(1)(a) of the FOI Act which states:

Refusal on Administrative Grounds to grant FOI requests:

15(1) A head to whom an FOI request is made may refuse to grant the request where –

(a) the record concerned does not exist or cannot be found after all reasonable steps to ascertain its whereabouts have been taken

I am also refusing to release records sought for the years 2014 to 2019. I am doing so in accordance with Section 15(1)(d) of the FOI Act which states:

Refusal on Administrative Grounds to grant FOI requests:

15. (1) A head to whom an FOI request is made may refuse to grant the request where – (d) the information is already in the public domain.

The information you seek in respect of the years 2014 to 2019 was the subject of a previous FOI request (FOI-000092-2021).
