Refuse - Out of Scope

Dear]

I refer to the Freedom of Information Act 2014 and your submission to An Garda Síochána dated and received on the 1st February 2016.

Part 1 (n) of Schedule 1 of the Freedom of Information Act 2014 states that An Garda Síochána is listed as a partially included agency “*insofar as it relates to administrative records relating to human resources, or finance or procurement matters*”. Therefore, only administrative records that relate to human resources, finance or procurement shall be considered.

Your request is shown below:

I am writing to request access to records held by An Garda Síochána under the Freedom of Information Act, 2014.

In accordance with section 12 of the Freedom of Information Act 2014, I wish to request access to the following records/details:

- A figure for the total number of arrests made in Ireland in 2015.

- A breakdown of the number of arrests, divided by which garda station those arrested were brought to following their arrests.

- This information to be given in tabulated form with the figures being presented by month, for example:

<i>Station</i>	<i>January</i>	<i>February</i>	<i>March</i>
<i>Donegal Town</i>	<i>13</i>	<i>12</i>	<i>32</i>
<i>Tallaght</i>	<i>24</i>	<i>15</i>	<i>54</i>
<i>Kevin Street</i>	<i>31</i>	<i>14</i>	<i>65</i>

I have now made a final decision to **refuse your request**

The purpose of this letter is to explain that decision.

1. Findings, particulars and reasons for decisions to deny access

I have decided that your request is out of the scope of the Act insofar as it relates to An Garda Síochána. Your request does not refer to administrative records relating to human resources, finance or procurement and therefore I am not providing access to the records requested.

However the information you seek may be available from the Central Statistics Office who receive all crime related data from An Garda Síochána under section 47 of the Garda Síochána Act 2005.

2. Right of appeal

You should submit your request for an Internal Review within 4 weeks from the date of this notification. The review will involve a complete reconsideration of the matter by a more senior member of An Garda Síochána and the decision will be communicated to you within 3 weeks. The making of a late appeal may be permitted in appropriate circumstances.
