Re: Freedom of Information Request FOI-000278-2016 Refusal

Dear

I refer to your request, dated and received on 22/07/2016 which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act (FOI) 2014 for records held by An Garda Síochána.

Part 1(n) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act states that An Garda Síochána is listed as a partially included agency "*insofar as it relates to administrative records relating to human resources, or finance or procurement matters*". Therefore, only administrative records that relate to human resources, finance or procurement shall be considered.

Your request sought:

- *Please can you email me figures on the number of incidents reported to police in the last 12 months that relate exclusively to Facebook, Twitter, eBay and other websites, including details where possible.*

I wish to inform you that I have decided to refuse your request on the 28th July 2016.

The purpose of this letter is to explain my decision.

1. Findings, particulars and reasons for decisions to deny access

Part 1(n) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act states that An Garda Síochána is listed as a partially included agency "*insofar as it relates to administrative records relating to human resources, or finance or procurement matters*". Therefore, only administrative records that relate to human resources, finance or procurement shall be considered. Your request is in relation to an operational policing matter which is a core function of An Garda Síochána. Records relating to the core functions of An Garda Síochána are excluded from the ambit of the FOI Act.

I am therefore refusing your request as it falls outside the scope of the FOI Act insofar as it pertains to An Garda Síochána.

However, the information you seek may be available from the Central Statistics Office which receives crime-related data from An Garda Síochána, and can be contacted at Skehard Road, Cork, T12 XOOE, Ireland. The Central Statistics Office can be emailed at crime@cs.o.ie and their website address is www@cs.o.ie

2. Right of appeal


You must ensure that your FOI reference number is included in the payment details.

The making of a late appeal may be permitted in appropriate circumstances.
