I refer to your request, dated and received on 4th January, 2023 which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 (FOI Act) for records held by An Garda Síochána.

Part 1(n) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act states that An Garda Síochána is listed as a partially included agency "insofar as it relates to administrative records relating to human resources, or finance or procurement matters". Therefore, only administrative records that relate to human resources, finance or procurement shall be considered.

Your request sought:

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2014, I wish to request a breakdown of injuries suffered by gardai in the course of duty by Garda division and type of injury for 2023 (and if a similar table is available for the same data for 2022 for comparative purposes.

I wish to inform you that I have decided to grant your request on 23rd January 2023.

The purpose of this letter is to explain that decision.

1. Findings, particulars and reasons for decision
