I refer to your request, dated and received on 30th August, 2023 which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 (FOI Act) for records held by An Garda Síochána.

Part 1(n) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act states that An Garda Síochána is listed as a partially included agency "insofar as it relates to administrative records relating to human resources, or finance or procurement matters". Therefore, only administrative records that relate to human resources, finance or procurement shall be considered.

Your request sought:

- 2. Number of new recruits in the division in the last 4 years.

- 4. Number of Gardai deemed non effective or on restricted duties by Garda Chief Medical Officer.
- 5. Number of Gardai eligible for retirement in the next 2 years.
