We are an independent organisation but work closely with other organisations in the criminal justice sector, in particular An Garda Síochána and the Courts Service of Ireland to provide the best service possible and/or a witness in criminal proceedings.

Our trained volunteers offer:

- Someone to talk to in confidence about the trial process
- Information about An Garda Síochána and court procedures
- Help in dealing with other organisations
- Information about victims' rights and the criminal injuries tribunal
- Information on other sources of help
